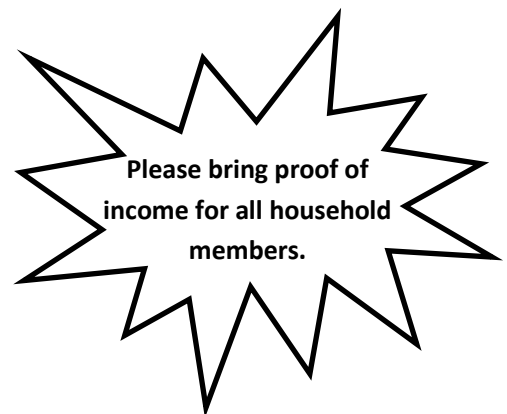


Home Energy Efficiency Kits
